



Tayside Children's Hospital Research Facility

The children's research facility is a service developed in collaboration with the Scottish Children's Research Network providing experienced paediatric research nurses to support and facilitate local research activity.

The research nurses are experienced paediatric nurses with expertise in communicating with children of all ages and health conditions which is an essential skill for obtaining consent and assent; a core aspect of research participation.

Research governance is supported by the utilisation of paediatric specific standard operating procedures.

The facility supports commercial, clinical and non-clinical research projects. It is a child friendly, safe environment for children of all ages and their families. The environment is a fully equipped four bedded open area with an isolation room, treatment room, drug preparation room and disposal room.
